<p><u>Program Classification: Unclassified</u></p> <p>3.13 - Inactivation and Disposal Support: Master Divers are highly trained, former military technicians currently providing classroom and water training for RQS units in US, UK and Japan. Military diver trainees are taught to follow Navy Dive Manual safety procedures and proper maintenance of diving and support equipment. The divers and small engine technicians, manage all aspects of the hazardous material program for the maritime section to include procurement, use, storage, inactivation and disposal support.</p> <p><u>Primary Processes and Procedures:</u> In response to the US Navy DoD mandate to be the single point manager and proponent for all military matters, the Navy Safety Center or designated Command agent will inspect each of the Rescue Squadrons (RQS) dive lockers every 12 months and not to exceed 18 months to ensure mission success and personnel safety.</p> <p>SSI provides highly qualified and experienced dive locker personnel with an extensive and practical knowledge of US Navy Maintenance and Material Management (3M) system; maintenance and repair of SCUBA and oxygen diving systems; maintenance and repair of assigned boats and outboard motors; and working knowledge of general Dive Locker/Maritime operations training procedures IAW with US Navy/MAJCOM standards.</p> <p>SSI divers perform routine environmental assessments required by installation environmental organizations through the Environmental, Safety, and Occupational Health Compliance Assessment Management Program (ESOH-CAMP) software program. Additionally, the team maintains the MSDS library IAW Federal, State, County, Air Force, and installation policies and procedures. SSI divers key performance areas currently support SeaPort-e functional area 3.13 to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide Dive Locker Maintenance support to various locations supporting; Air Combat Command (ACC), Pacific Air forces (PACAF), United States Air Force in Europe (USAFE), and Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC). • Assist Guardian Angel (GA) RQS by providing technical training in the operation and maintenance of assigned diving equipment, boats and outboard motors IAW Manufacturer Specifications, and operation of boats during unit dive operations. • SSI dive locker technicians support the development of waterborne operations procedures designed to enhance the combat readiness and collective skills of Combat Rescue Officers and Para rescue men.
